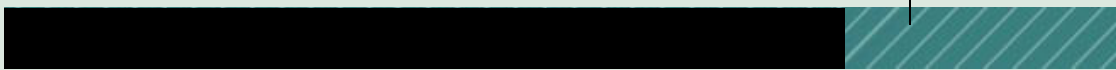

Younger people reported losing money to fraud more often than older people.

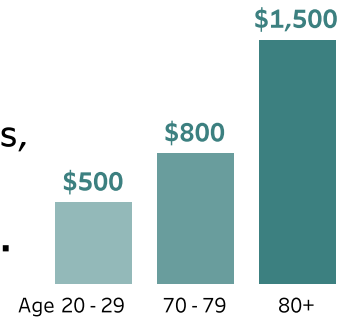
